Tax Receipts: If you need a tax receipt for tuition paid during the 2019 calendar year, please request this from Bobbie.

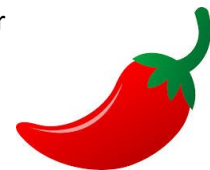
